- Need financial assistance to complete education or upgrade skills

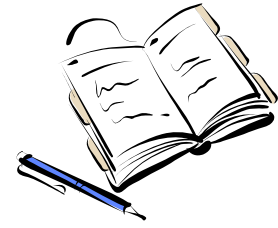
